Admissions Requirements

If you are a Freshman applicant (both International and US student) you must submit the following documents:

- 1. Admissions Application- which you will access online: https://patsiprod.upr.edu
- 2. SAT scores and SAT Subject Test: Literature, Reading and Mathematics Level I or Level II. If you took the SAT test multiple times, only the best result scores for each subject will be considered in calculating your General Index for Admissions (IGS*- Spanish acronym). Remember to use the UPR- Mayaguez Campus code: 0912 to submit your results. It is important to know that ACT is not accepted.
- 3. Your high school transcript including the mid-year school grades in your senior year High school transcripts must be submitted with the official school seal and the authorized signature of the person who prepared the transcript.

*IGS: The index is calculated using the student's high school Grade Point Average (GPA)(equivalent to 50%) and the SAT Scores (equivalent to 25% for the Reasoning Test in Math and Critical Reading).

The minimum scores (IGS) for each program of study in the Mayaguez Campus are evaluated every academic year. You can find an IGS calculator and the minimum scores per program at the following link: http://www.uprm.edu/p/prepas/indices_minimos_de_ingreso

If you are a Transfer applicant, Visiting Student, or a professional development applicant you must submit the following documents:

- 1. Admission application for transfer student, visiting student, or professional development applicant which you will access online at:

 - Application fee receipt for the amount \$33.00 if submitted on time or \$49.50 if submitted late. You may pay your application fee online with a credit card or send a check or money order to University of Puerto Rico. The fee is non-refundable.
 - Two official transcripts. If you attended more than one college or university, you will need to send the transcripts from each college. A student copy will **not** be accepted. Please have all transcripts sent directly to UPR- Mayaguez Campus/Admission Office.

In order to be considered as a candidate for transfer, visiting student or professional development you should have the following requirements:

Transfer: At least 48 credits must be approved at the institution where you were or are currently enrolled. Each program has minimum requirements. Please contact the program to request information. Once admitted, the department will evaluate the courses taken at the previous institution to determine which will be accredited to your program.

Visiting Students: Your current University must provide an authorization for you to take courses at University of Puerto Rico, Mayaguez Campus.

Professional development: Students who have completed a bachelor's degree can take a maximum 18 credits as a professional development student.
